- Operate Powered Tools and Equipment during Gas Network Operations (Service laying)
- Install Engineering Products or Assets (Service laying)
- Replace Assembly or Sub-Assembly Components (Service laying)
- Conduct Specified Testing of Engineering Products or Assets (Service laying)
- Prepare Resources and Segregate the Area for Highways Works during Gas Network Operations (Service laying)
- Join Materials by Machine Controlled Thermal Processes (Service laying)
- Control Allocated Resources to Achieve Requirements (Service laying)
- Prepare Work Areas and Materials for Engineering Activities (Service laying)
